“What Your Leaders Are Not Telling You—and Why”¹

My dear grandchildren,

You are being told that obedience is virtue, that doubt is danger, and that your leaders speak for God. What you are not being told is that those same leaders know far more than they admit, and that they rely on your innocence to keep you from learning it too soon.

They know Joseph Smith’s record does not withstand scrutiny. They know the Book of Abraham and the Book of Mormon cannot be translations. They know the Temple ceremony was designed to command loyalty before thought. They know these things not as rumors but as settled scholarship. And yet they proceed, calmly and confidently, to ask for your life, your time, your money, your obedience—without disclosure.

That is not faith. That is **withholding material truth from minors while demanding irrevocable commitments from you.**

When leaders quietly move the spotlight from Joseph Smith to Jesus without acknowledging why, they are not guiding you toward truth; they are steering you around it. When Moroni disappears from temples without explanation, it is not revelation—it is embarrassment without honesty. When criticism is forbidden “even if true,” the problem is no longer belief but **fear of accountability.**²

You deserve a religion that tells you the truth before asking for your loyalty. You deserve leaders who trust your conscience rather than fear it. And you deserve the right to author your own life without guilt or coercion.

Anything less is not worthy of you.
